Several Key Projects Completed at the Canadian Rockies International Airport

Cranbrook, B.C. - (November 10, 2009) – Cranbrook Airport Services Ltd. along with the City of Cranbrook is pleased to announce the completion of a number of key customer focused projects at the Canadian Rockies International Airport.

The Memorial Garden was commissioned to provide a place of quiet reflection and remembrance for the aircraft incident of February 1978. The garden is available to visit anytime. It is located at the South end of the terminal building and includes a water feature around a plaque donated by East Kootenay MLA Bill Bennett. Also featured will be two hand made cedar benches which will be delivered at the beginning of December and installed in the spring.

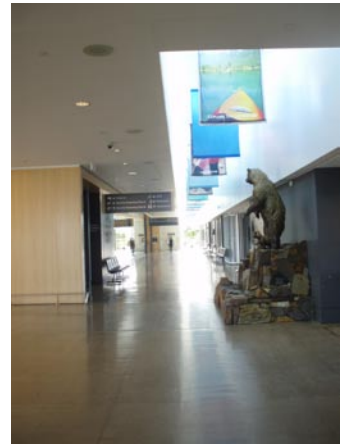
The Arts Program includes local photographer's works in the form of banners and wall hangings in addition to the bronze sculpture of a Grizzly sow and cubs. A First Nations display is featured in the Departures area of the terminal. Photographs throughout the terminal building include local Olympic Gold Medalist Ben Rutledge, Stanley Cup winner Scott Niedermayer, and various photos of the natural beauty and outdoor activities that the East Kootenay area is famous for.

The new Airport Entrance Sign has been completed and installed on Airport Access Road. New Airport and City branding is displayed. Landscaping and additional lighting will be added at the base of the sign in the springtime.

In addition, complimentary wireless internet is now available in the terminal building for passengers awaiting departure.

Remember, Delta Air Lines winter service to Salt Lake City will be resuming on December 19th, 2009. Service continues on Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday.





The Canadian Rockies International Airport has twice daily service to Vancouver International Airport with Air Canada Jazz and three times daily service to the South Terminal of YVR with Pacific Coastal Airlines. There is also twice daily service to Calgary with Air Canada Jazz and Central Mountain Air. A third flight to Calgary will be reinstated on December 19th.
